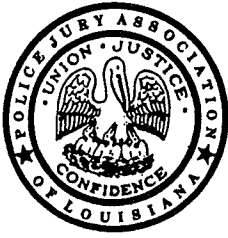

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The Governor's Office of Homeland Security in partnership with the Louisiana State Police are pleased to announce the *First Annual Parish Leadership Summit for Homeland Security and Emergency Management*. Please mark your calendars and save the date of **April 15, 2010**.

The purpose of the Parish Leadership Summit is to convene parish leadership from Louisiana's 64 parishes and to build upon the communication, collaboration, and coordination that exists today and was highlighted in the successful state and local responses to Hurricanes Gustav, Ike, and other declared disasters throughout the state. The summit will also examine best practices in leadership, command and control, and crisis management by hearing from national leaders in emergency management and homeland security. The State has already confirmed Governor Jindal to speak, as well as Los Angeles County Fire Chief P. Michael Freeman, United States Attorney of the Eastern District of Louisiana, Jim Letten and FBI Special Agent in Charge David Welker of the New Orleans Field Office. Other nationally known speakers have been invited to share their experiences with us as well.

We invite all Parish Presidents, Sheriffs, OEP Directors and the official Fire Chief representative that sits on each Parish Emergency Management Advisory Committee to take part in this first ever leadership summit. Therefore, given limited seating, only these four representatives from each parish are invited to attend.

A final list of speakers as well as more detailed information including the agenda, available hotels, other accommodations, and RSVP information will be released as soon as details are finalized. There is no registration cost associated with these events, however, you will be responsible for your own hotel reservation and expense.
